<u>CurePSP (Progressive Supranuclear Palsy) Student Fellowship</u> Deadline: Jan 31, 2017

The Urso Summer Student Program in PSP Research will support students conducting summer research projects focused on progressive supranuclear palsy. This award is open to MD and non-MD **undergraduate students**. Projects may be in basic, translational, clinical or epidemiological aspects of PSP, and must be supervised by a faculty mentor with expertise in the field. A maximum stipend of \$3,000 will be awarded. Awardees are expected present their research at the Annual CurePSP Research Symposium in the fall.

Canadian Celiac Association Dr. J. A. Campbell Young Investigator Award Deadline: Jan 31, 2017

The Canadian Celiac Association is offering an award to conduct research of a scientific, applied science, medical, or social-economic nature relevant to celiac disease, dermatitis herpetiformis, or other gluten-related disorders. This award is open to **MD and non-MD undergraduate and graduate students**, including recent graduates. Students must identify a mentor who will oversee their project. A maximum award of \$5,000 will be awarded (including both salary and direct research costs). Refer to the website for detailed application guidelines.

<u>CSNS/CNS Medical Student Summer Fellowship in Socioeconomic Research</u> (Neurosurgery) Deadline: Feb 1, 2017

The Congress of Neurological Surgeons (CNS) is offering a Summer Fellowship in Socioeconomic Research to **medical students**. The successful applicant will receive a stipend of \$2,500 and will spend 8 to 10 weeks conducting supervised research on a socioeconomic topic of importance to neurosurgery. The student must submit a final report to the CNS Fellowships Committee and present their research at the spring or fall CSNS meeting. Students must have completed at least one year of medical school and find a supervisor who is a member of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons (AANS). Society of Interventional Radiology Dr. and Mrs. W.C. Culp Student Research Grant Deadline: Feb 1, 2017

The Dr. and Mrs. W.C. Culp Student Research Grant for **MD and non-MD undergraduate students** is intended to foster an interest in research and provide up to \$4000 for students conducting a summer research project in interventional radiology and patient care. Students must be citizens or permanent residents of Canada or the US and must identify a supervisor who will mentor them for the duration of their project. Awardees must submit a final written report upon project completion. Applicants can submit a Proposal Development form to the SIR to receive preliminary feedback on their research proposal.
