Title: Automated Confounding Control in Comparative Effectiveness Research: Help or Hype?

The CHÉOS Work in Progress (WiP) Seminar Series takes place on alternate Wednesdays from 12:00-1:00pm. WiP presentations provide investigators with an opportunity to present ongoing research, obtain feedback from colleagues and peers, and make connections for their projects. Attendance is open to all and a light lunch is served.

Speaker **Dr. Ehsan Karim's** (CHÉOS scientist and biostatistician) research focuses on causal inference and observational data analyses in cross-sectional and longitudinal studies.
