Speaker: <u>Dr. Yuri Danilov</u>, <u>PhD</u>: Senior Scientist and Honorary Fellow, Department of Biomedical Engineering, Orthopedics and Rehabilitation, Tactile Communication and Neuromudulation Laboratory (TCNL), University of Wisconsin-Madison.

Dr. Danilov has over 35 years of experience in research on brain function and the special senses, including vision, taste, hearing and balance. Dr. Danilov is the lead discoverer of the balance retention effect, lead development of the specific training regimens, and continues to identify potential clinical and non-clinical applications of neuromodulation and sensory substitution technology. Dr. Danilov is currently focusing on traumatic brain injury, stroke, multiple sclerosis, and Parkinson's disease. His interest areas are neuroplasticity, neurorehabilitation, enhancement of human performance, and extension of human sensory systems.
