Data miners use this information to predict your behaviour (such as who you will vote for) or figure out personal details about you (such as whether you are pregnant or not). It is easy to be alarmed. But how powerful really are the techniques in data mining? Dr. Tupper will provide a skeptical look at some of the surprising claims of the new data science.

St. Paul's Hospital is pleased to be hosting Dr. Lap-Chee Tsui. Dr. Tsui has had many academic accomplishments in his illustrious 40 year career in research. His most famous accomplishment was the discovery of the delta F508 mutation in the Cystic Fibrosis Transmembrane Conductance Regulator (CFTR) gene, which is responsible for >80% cases of Cystic Fibrosis (CF) in Canada. Since his discovery, the treatment of patients with CF has radically improved, leading to improved quality of life and a doubling of survival rate. In recognition of his enormous contribution to CF care, in 1991 Dr. Tsui received the Order of Canada and 2012 he was inducted into the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame. In 2014, he received the prestigious Henry G. Friezen International Prize in Health Research. We invite you to join us for this special presentation to honor this great Canadian who has impacted the lives of millions of patients with Cystic Fibrosis in Canada and around the world.
