BC Cancer Agency Studentships

Deadline: Feb 12, 2014

Up to 10 summer research studentships will be available to support senior undergraduate students and/or junior medical or dental students seeking hands-on training in cancer research in British Columbia during the period of May 1 - August 31, 2014. These summer studentships may address any discipline of cancer research including clinical, translational, basic, behavioural and population research areas. These awards may be held at any BCCA site of operation in the province but are restricted to applicants planning to work on a research project that is funded and supervised by a senior health professional that has an appointment in the B.C. Cancer Agency. In addition, the Canadian Breast Cancer Foundation B.C. and Yukon Chapter is providing funding for 2 summer studentships specifically directed towards breast cancer research; these awards are open to any academic researcher working in the province.
