April 11: Conferencing Well

A conference is more than just an opportunity to present work and to hear others present theirs in

formal sessions. It is also an important networking opportunity. It provides the chance to 1) renew and reinforce relationships with colleagues from other institutions; 2) meet and develop an active relationship with people whose work you have been reading; 3) get "rapid peer review" of ideas that you have been developing; and 4) showcase your recent work. Taking advantage of these opportunities requires planning in advance of the conference (identifying people you are going to try to meet, setting up certain meetings in advance, planning and practicing what will you say when people ask you about your current activities, picking a few new ideas to share for feedback and refinement). It also requires active effort at the conference (finding out where people hang out, going to the social activities, actively seeking out people and NOT just spending time with the crowd from you own institution, paying active attention to people's responses to your research ideas and refining them for the interaction). Finally, it requires intentional follow up after the conference (emailing those you spoke with, following through on conference promises). At this session, we will be discussing and elaborating (and practicing) these social aspects of the conference venue.
