Application deadline: Jan 12th, 2024

Amount: \$5,000

The goal of this grant is to provide support for medical students who are interested in research in infectious diseases and microbiology. This grant is funded for \$5,000 for a 10-12 week research term, performed consecutively over the summer or intermittently over the course of one academic year. Adjudication is by a selection committee and will be competitive based on academic achievement, research potential or experience, and mentor acceptance. The awardee is required to submit a summary report within 4 weeks of the termination of their project, which will be published on the AMMI Canada and the CFID websites. The student is also encouraged to submit a poster or oral presentation on their work at the subsequent annual AMMI Canada/CACMID meeting. Click the link above for more information.

Amount: Ranges \$6,000 for 12 weeks, \$5,000 for 10 weeks and \$4,000 for 8 weeks.

The BC Children’s Hospital Research Institute (BCCHR) Summer Student Research Program encourages MD and non-MD undergraduate students to conduct research in improving the health of children and families. Funding is provided for an optional 8, 10 or 12-week period between May and August. Successful applicants will receive a stipend of \$6,000 for 12 weeks, \$5,000 for 10 weeks and \$4,000 for 8 weeks. Amount: \$3,000

The Student Research Fellowship, established by the Society for Vascular Surgery (SVS) Foundation, intends to further student education and introduce rigorous scientific methods to clinical problems and underlying biologic processes important to patients with vascular disease. MD and non-MD undergraduate students at universities in the US and Canada are eligible to apply. The award is designed for students to spend time on a project with a minimum commitment of 2 months and a maximum of 12 months. Applicants must also be sponsored by an active member of SVS. Each award consists of a \$3,000 student stipend and a two-year complimentary subscription to the Journal of Vascular Surgery. For application details, visit their website.

The Eye Foundation of Canada is offering scholarships for students to spend the summer furthering their education in ophthalmic medicine, surgery, and research. Nis Schmidt History of Surgery Prize

We are delighted to invite paper submissions on the History of Surgery from trainees for the Nis Schmidt History of Surgery Prize.

Dr. Schmidt is a UBC Department of Surgery Clinical Professor Emeritus who has generously endowed an award to stimulate interest and documentation in the history of surgery. A monetary prize is awarded annually to a trainee in the Department of Surgery for the best publishable grade paper on the subject of surgical history. The paper can address a topic of local, national or international interest in any field of surgery - biographical, developmental, clinical, technical, educational and ethical and is open to undergraduate medical students and residents in any surgical discipline. The winning paper will be presented at the Department of Surgery Grand Rounds on April 10th, 2024.
